

Board Resolution

Acknowledging Temporary Injunction in *Mirabelli v. Bonta* and Direction Pending Final Judicial Resolution.

WHEREAS, Para Los Niños (“PLN”) is committed to complying with all applicable federal and state laws while ensuring student safety, parental rights, and nondiscrimination; and

WHEREAS, a federal district court injunction, currently in effect for a limited class of parents in *Mirabelli v. Bonta*, temporarily restricts enforcement of certain California guidance related to parental notification and the use of names and pronouns under specific circumstances; and

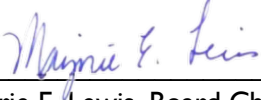
WHEREAS, the injunction is narrow in scope, subject to ongoing appellate review, and a final ruling is not expected until late 2026 or later; and

WHEREAS, courts and legal counsel have advised that no new policy adoption is required at this time, but that local educational agencies may document their understanding and implementation approach during the pendency of the litigation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Para Los Niños:

1. **Acknowledges** the current injunction in *Mirabelli v. Bonta* and PLN’s obligation to comply with it as applicable to the defined parent subclass;
2. **Directs** that any existing policy provisions that conflict with the injunction shall not be enforced while the litigation remains pending;
3. **Affirms** that all other state and federal requirements—including nondiscrimination, anti-bullying, FERPA, facility access, and mandated reporting—remain in full force and effect;
4. **Authorizes** the continued use of PLN’s current policy, as attached, subject to the limitations imposed by the injunction;
5. **Delegates** to the Compliance & Risk Department the authority to issue administrative guidance, parent notices, and procedures consistent with evolving legal requirements; and
6. **Provides** that this Resolution shall remain in effect until a final judicial determination or further Board action.
